## Inform '96 CD.UNIX

The presentations contained in the Inform '96 CD can only be read by Adobe Acrobat<sup>TM</sup> Reader. To read the files, you must first install and launch the application.

This file describes how to perform the following tasks;

- Install Adobe Acrobat<sup>TM</sup> Reader
- Launch the reader
- Read the plenaries and workshop files

Installing Adobe Acrobat<sup>TM</sup> Reader:

1. Mount the CD into your CD-ROM drive.

Type "cd /cdrom"

Select "2install"

Type "cd 2install"

You will then see three options appear.

Choose "acrounix"

2. Launch your UNIX<sup>TM</sup> applications.

The root is "16882"

If you encounter problems, please go to the file marked INSTGUID.TXT. Root 18406

This will activate the Acroread.exe installer program.

By default, the program will now install the Adobe Acrobat 2.1 folder on your hard drive.

. Go into the Adobe Acrobat 2.1 folder and double-click on the Acrobat Reader icon. This will launch the application.

Select the Inform CD when prompted by the dialogue window.

Go into the folder marked 3INFORM.

Proceed to read the document marked 1SYNOPSI.PDF which contains the synopsis of all the presentations contained in the CD.

To open any of the presentations, simply click on the color-highlighted name of the workshop in the 1SYNOPSI.PDF document.

The hypertext links will automatically open the selected presentation.
