


Processing Area Network

- Processing resources
 are integrated into one
 convenient package, purpose built for the data center.
- Processing Blades are modular.
 Plug in as many
 as you want. No
 "installation" needed.
- Processing Blades are anonymous and stateless.
 Enables flexible configuration and failover.



Processing Area Network

- I/O is managed through Control Blades. Minimizes cabling, enables configuration and failover.
- A built-in high-speed interconnect glues everything together.
- Everything is redundant for availability and throughput.
- Easy logical configuration
 replaces tedious physical
 configuration. Define servers in
 software, even remotely.

 Create virtual networks in moments from virtual interfaces and virtual switches. Enjoy redundancy and high throughput.
